#### **Highlights and Key Points:**

- Mr. Nagesh Vuda from Advanta invited the gathering and shared Advanta's commitment towards Human Rights compliance in their seed production farms
- Dr. Davuluri shared about evolution of Child Care Program (CCP) and later recent transformation in to ECHO (Enabling Child and Human Rights with Seed Organizations) forum consisting of 16 seed companies. He also talked about increasing challenges in child labour issue especially in Gujarat due to exemption of family children during vacation and before school hours as per amendment of Child Labour Act. With regard to minimum wages which is also a focus area for ECHO, awareness levels have been increased due to continuous dialoguing with stakeholders. However, compliance status of minimum wages for farm labour is alarming especially for women labour across all states.
- Mr. Ranjith Prakash from ILO had shared key details of their 3-year project initiated in 2018 on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work (FPRW) with a focus on Child labour, forced labour, discrimination and Collective bargaining in cotton farms (seed production and commercial) inTelangana state in collaboration with state government and NGOs. He also appreciated ECHO member companies and Dr. Davuluri for their continued and unique efforts on Human Rights issues since more than a decade and assured ILO support and collaboration with ECHO for future and relevant initiatives besides influencing government to focus more on field inspections, timely release of minimum wage notification etc., He also highlighted the fact that as per ILO conventions, non-payment of minimum wages is considered as forced labour
- ECHO state level subcommittees from Karnataka and Maharashtra shared their collaborative events conducted at respective locations. ECHO forum felt that they need to further intensify and have a yearly calendar for conducting diversified programs by seed companies locally.
- Representatives of seed companies shared their 2018-19 season highlights, monitoring results. Syngenta and Bayer shared their project details on minimum wages in seed production farms and challenges encountered. In this context, Mr. Ranjith Prakash appraised the forum that New wage code is awaiting Parliament approval which solves many issues related to fixing of minimum wages.
- Mr Rajendra Prasad from MV Foundation presented MVF's perspective and field experiences in addressing child labour in agriculture and other sectors and recent learnings from Child Labour Free Zones (CLFZ) projects implemented in different parts of the country.
- Ms. Jeena from PHF (Public Health Foundation of India) shared her research study highlights on health impacts of girl children working in cotton farms.

• Participants had group discussion on minimum wages issue and shared challenges and way forward as detailed below:

#### Challenges:

- ✓ Timely release of government notifications prior to onset of crop season
- ✓ Conducting awareness programs to farm labour and farmers on compliance with minimum wages, require support from NGOs
- ✓ Pressure from fellow commercial farmers and managing related village level dynamics
- ✓ Ensuring payment of minimum wages by farmer to farm labour, related documentation and monitoring
- ✓ Criteria for payment of minimum wages for contract work, piece work etc.,
- ✓ Classification of farm work in to skilled, semi-skilled and unskilled

#### Way forward:

- ✓ Calculation of minimum wages based on assumption or average annual increase historically, in case of delay in government notifications.
- ✓ Company representatives to pursue with local labour department on latest notifications
- ✓ Companies to have a policy, system and road map on minimum wages compliance
- ✓ To ensure relevant clauses in grower agreements as bare minimum
- ✓ To identify agencies or NGOs locally for creating awareness on minimum wages for farmers and farm labour
- ✓ Mandatory compliance by companies where they have direct control on labour employment like nurseries, R&D farms, big farms, processing plants etc.,
- ✓ Third party audit in aforesaid areas annually to check the compliance
- ✓ Companies to conduct minimum wages gap analysis to under asis situation in contract seed farms
- ✓ Contract seed farms: To pilot minimum wages project in few villages in less risky locations
- Mr. Rishi Pathania of UPL Advanta very briefly shared about recent revised CSR norms
- ECHO new logo has been launched and shared with all members and modalities for ECHO registration modalities were briefed
- UPL team who had hosted the meeting thanked all member companies, NGO participants and ILO for having fruitful deliberations and outcome
